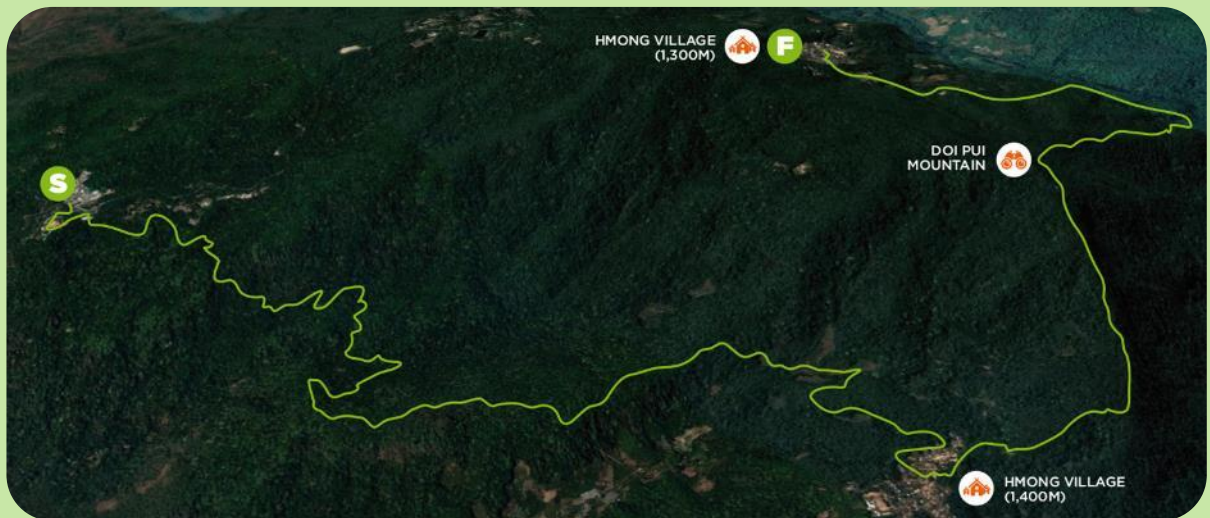

DETAILS OF THE DAY

17K & 900m+

Wat Doi Suthep – Ban Doi Pui

Pick up at hotel & Transfer to starting point (30mn)

1st part trekking: in the wild jungle

Break and lunch in a Hmong village

2nd part trekking: Doi Pui Mountain

Finish at Ban Doi Pui

Transfer back (45mn) & Drop off at hotel (around 4-5pm)

INFORMATION

TMT trekking trips are real trekking trips. They take place in remote areas and in high mountains on wild paths with a certain difference in altitude. Our trips are dedicated to people with a minimum level of physical fitness. You don't need to be a marathon runner or an athlete, but a good physical condition is recommended.
